Tri-Lakes Family YMCA Update

Quick Facts:

- Future site of the Tri-Lakes Family YMCA: Jackson Creek Parkway near Higby Road directly across from Lewis Palmer High School.
- The total project goal for the Tri-Lakes Family YMCA is \$15.8 million
- Total amount raised to date: Approximately \$10.1 million
- Ground breaking occurred on April 12th, 2007
- Anticipated opening date: March 2008

Capital Campaign:

- The Capital Campaign is being led by Lynn Spear with Tom Harbert chairing the major gifts phase and Cindy Brandt chairing the community gifts phase.
- Currently, we are recruiting volunteers to help raise money locally. We are in the process of building teams in Gleneagle, Palmer Lake and the Black Forest.
- Support from local individuals and businesses is critical in the fundraising efforts in order to demonstrate broad based community support to major foundations.

The Building:

- The design, presented by LKA & Associates has been approved by the volunteer Building Committee and is available for viewing at the Tri-Lakes YMCA offices and at www.ppymca.org.
- 45,000 square feet of program, child care and community space.

Future Programs:

- People of all ages will find something at the Tri-Lakes YMCA.
- For infants and toddlers, swim lessons and Gymventures classes will be offered throughout the week.
- Older children will enjoy sports programs and the state of the art gymnasium.
- Adults will find the fitness center and various group exercise classes are great choices for physical health.
- Seniors will appreciate water aerobics and arthritis classes along with the dynamic social opportunities of the Active Older Adults program.

Benefits to the Community:

- The new YMCA will be a safe place for teens to go after school, during summer and on holidays.
- A place for the entire family to participate in healthy activities.
- Increased property values throughout Tri-Lakes region.
- Community room available for meetings and gatherings of local organizations and groups.
- Turf field will be first centrally located playing field and open to everyone.

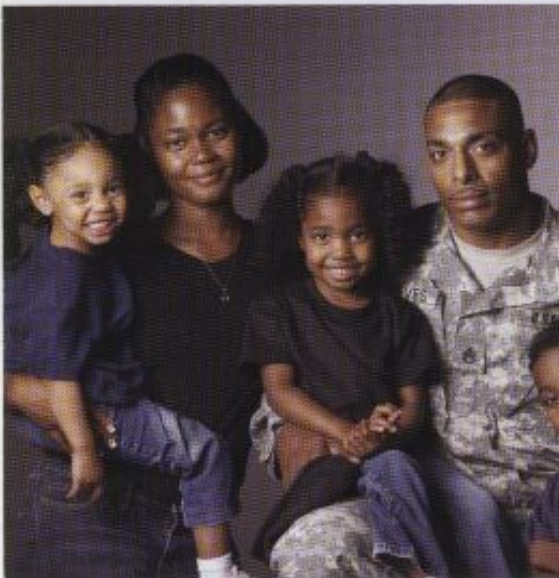
